2018 Activities and Accomplishments

Services for Individuals with Disabilities: Greatest Needs Fund Grant to a spinal cord injured person to purchase a quad stick, costing \$689. Date: 6/10/2018

Services for Individuals with Disabilities: Greatest Needs Fund Grant to a spinal cord injured person to purchase a wheelchair, costing \$600. Date: 10/20/2018

Leisure & Recreational Activities Programs: A picnic was held for members and their families. (32 individuals attended) Date: 9/15/2018

Key volunteer recognition: Fourteen \$5 gift cards awarded to volunteers during 9/15/2018 picnic.

Diseases & Disorders Research: Provide \$3,000 grant to the Medical College of Wisconsin to support SCI research towards improving the immediate treatments persons with spinal cord injuries receive with the goal of minimizing the severity of the injury. Date: 11/30/2018

Scholarship Programs: One educational scholarship to chapter members or their families who have some form of spinal cord injury or impairment.

• \$500 Moraine Park Tech College: 3/30/2018

Specialized Human Services Programs: Volunteers Staff a barrier free climate controlled respite center for physically and/or emotionally disabled, and/or elderly and/or nursing mothers on the Milwaukee lakefront festival grounds during all summer festivals. The respite center has large fully accessible family bathrooms, changing / shower facilities, storage lockers and a large open area for resting. (1,830 people served)

In 2018 we expended \$8,582 for the above listed program services, \$1,110 on fund raising expense and \$1,229 on administrative expense.
